




He has identified a significant need to update Arabia's member directory. As we continue to adapt our work using virtual meetings that keep us safe from the virus, maintaining a strong communication network is more important than ever and starts with accurate membership information.

To this need, Illustrious Rick Peña has set a goal for an updated membership directory to be ready for review by the end of February (this year). We have several tools that speed up this process including an online membership portal. Many of us may not be familiar with WebFez hosted by Shriners International, but this directory is used by Imperial leadership and all Temples to keep us informed about events, news, and meetings via email and mail.

If you have already registered with WebFez, now is the time to login and confirm your contact information by checking your email address, mobile phone number and physical mailing address. Why should we update all three? Any of these can change during the year. Important communications are sent using all three routes - just in case one of these has changed, the other two will still reach you.

Smart mobile phones and email offer another convenient way to stay in touch. Text messaging service is in process of being added to enhance the delivery of timely, short notes sent directly to your mobile phone. Text messaging services usually continue to operate even if cellular networks cannot support voice calls.

If you have not used WebFez, we are here to help. Registration is easy and can be done from any device with web access. Just go to

<https://webfez.shrinenet.org> and click on REGISTER. The only info you need to create a login are your home Temple name, member number and email address. Once connected, fill in the address, phone, and other fields as you want, like nickname and spouse. This is all that needs to be done: Remember to click REGISTER to save your information.
